

Country Thunder 2009 Camping Rules & Regulations

Camping Registration Hours:

Tuesday	March 31st	12:00pm - 10:00pm
Wednesday	April 1st	8:00am - 10:00pm

Friday	April 3rd	8:00am - 10:00pm

1. **Every campsite must be registered to 1 responsible adult** – this person **MUST be over 18 years of age** and accepts full responsibility for the campsite – any rules broken may mean eviction with **NO REFUND – Absolutely NO EXCEPTIONS**

2. **Under Age Drinking will NOT be permitted in the campgrounds or on the event grounds** – anyone found participating in or contributing to under age drinking will be brought to the attention of local law enforcement personnel, and will be evicted from the grounds immediately without refund. If you are of age and plan to drink alcoholic beverages, please carry your age identification with you at all times, (even after being wrist banded) as you may be stopped by undercover patrols. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

3. **Everyone entering the campgrounds must have a 4-day Event wristband.**

4. **No Ground Fires Allowed.** Weather permitting; campfires will be permitted in confined, approved containers with bottoms. Containers may be Maximum of 30” high by 36” in diameter. You may burn firewood **ONLY**- **NO** burning of processed or scrap lumber.

5. Prohibited items include: bottles and other glass containers, **NO WEAPONS OF ANY KIND**, fireworks, or live music performances. No swimming pools, dance floors, staging or other structures allowed. **No ATV's, Golf Carts, Quads, Mopeds, Bicycles, Skateboards, Roller blades, Scooters or any similar devices allowed** – with the exception of those permitted for handicapped transportation; unauthorized vehicles will be impounded and Country Thunder accepts no responsibility for such impounded vehicles. **Country Thunder reserves the right to make additional regulations as the situation warrants.** All decisions of Country Thunder are final.

6. **No Cruising or Riding in the back of open vehicles.**

7. **No Parking on Campground Roads** – We must keep these roads clear. If illegally parked on a campground road, your vehicle will be towed and impounded with a fine.

8. One vehicle is allowed per campsite under the campsite fee - **NOTE:** You may purchase additional vehicle 4-day passes for \$40.00. All vehicles parked in a campsite must have a parking sticker that corresponds with that campsite, clearly displayed in the vehicle at all times.

9. All Generators (gas/diesel) must be turned off at 1:00am (be kind to your neighbors).

10. Quiet Time must be observed, no loud noise – **Quiet Time** established so that those who wish can go to sleep. Normal conversation noise level **ONLY** for the following time periods: Starlight Preferred Campgrounds 1am-7am; Road Runner & Coyote Campgrounds 2am – 7am

11. **No soliciting on site** – includes food, beverage, merchandise and entertainment, or any item. Unauthorized selling of items will result in seizure of merchandise, eviction and possible prosecution.

12. **Grounds for Eviction: No 4-Day Event Wristband, Garbage filled campsite, drinking and driving, aggressive pets, excessive noise, and unauthorized sale of food, beverage or merchandise on site.**

13. No overnight parking in daily lots.

14. Place all bagged and tied garbage in containers for 6:00am pick-up.

The facility reserves the right to refuse admission or eject any person without refund who is violating the facility, local, state, or federal laws or whose conduct is deemed illegal, disorderly, or offensive by management.

IMPORTANT NOTE ON THE SIZE OF YOUR CAMPING UNIT:

If your camping unit is larger than your site it is considered Oversized. ALL OVERSIZED Camp Units MUST purchase 2 campsites. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. The site next to your original campsite may not be available for purchase, so in that case, you will be moved to a special location that can better accommodate your oversized camper.

All Campsite Sizes are 20' x 40'

PETS NOTICE

We love our pets, but Country Thunder strongly recommends that you leave your pets at home. The crowds at events like Country Thunder cause distress to many animals, and animals have been stolen at similar events around the nation.

If you do bring a pet to Country Thunder, you are responsible for your pet. Pets must be LEASHED and must be kept at your campsite at all times. You are responsible for cleaning up after your pet. Keep your pet safe and secured on your campsite.

No Pets will be allowed into the event grounds at any time. Aggressive pets are not allowed, and will be evicted or removed from the campground. Violators are subject to eviction from the event and campgrounds **without** refund.

If you have rented a Port-a-Potty and wish to secure it, please plan to provide your own locking device – locks will not be available for rent.

Must Be Signed By Responsible Registrant Upon Entering the Campgrounds

No one allowed on the campsite until the site is registered.

By signing below, I certify that I am **18 years old or older**, and that I read and **fully understand and agree to** all of the rules and notes listed on the Country Thunder Campsite Rules pages. I accept personal responsibility for my campsite number/s listed below, and understand that any rules broken on my campsite/s may mean I will be fined and/or ejected from the event and/or campgrounds without refund. I understand that Country Thunder assumes no liability for personal loss, injury, death, property damage or other harm suffered by participants, spectators, event site owners, lessors or others who may be adversely affected by this “Event” and/or causes of actions resulting therefrom. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Country Thunder, its officers, directors, subsidiaries, affiliates, parent companies, partners, Event Sponsors, et al. from any liability resulting from personal loss, injury, death, property damage or other harm suffered by participants, spectators, event site owners, lessors or others who may be adversely affected by this “Event” and/or causes of actions resulting therefrom.

Hwy 79 North out of Florence take approx. 2 • miles. Just before railroad tracks turn right onto Price Rd. Watch for signs.
